3/4/08 Derrick Douglas convicted of Attempted Possession of Schedule II Drugs

Derrick Douglas (DOB 6/12/70) was convicted by a 6 person jury of Attempted Possession of Schedule II Drugs. As the defendant is now a convicted 4th Felony Offender, the charge of Attempted Possession of Schedule II Drugs will carry a maximum penalty of 20 years to Life. Sentence will be imposed by Judge Mike Erwin on April 11, 2008. This conviction was obtained by felony prosecutors Philip House and David deBlieux.
